Archway receives grant from Abel Foundation

Kearney, Neb. – The Archway received a \$7,500 grant from the Abel Foundation to assist in the replacement of sidewalks and entrance pads at The Archway. The grant application was submitted with help from the Economic Development Council of Buffalo County.

Along with replacing the sidewalks, a concrete base was created to display a donated bronze statue that will be unveiled July 31 at the Archway Society Trailblazer festival. “The walkways were in desperate need of replacement and really didn’t reflect well on the quality of the attraction. The new walkways are ready to greet the Archway’s next 1.5 million visitors,” said Darren Robinson, President of the Economic Development Council.
